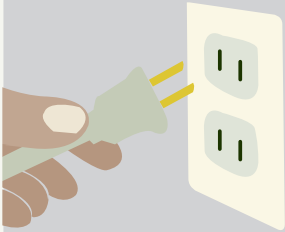
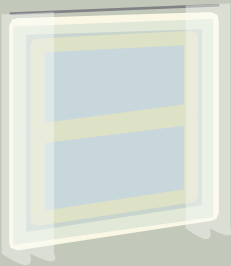


Energy Saving Tips
