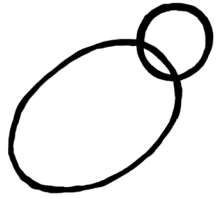
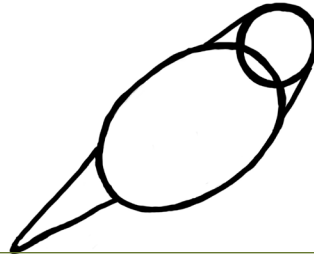


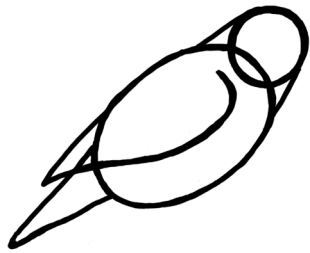
HOW TO DRAW A YELLOW WARBLER



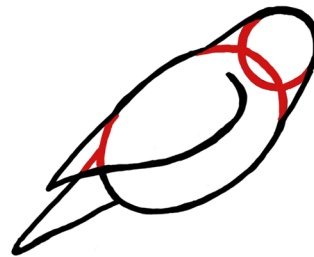
1. Draw a large oval. Then draw a small circle overlapping the large oval lightly in pencil. This will form the Basic shape of the body.



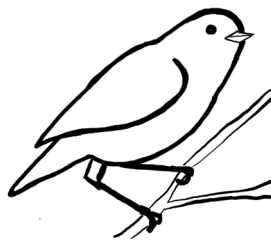
2. Add two lines to connect the circle and the oval. Then add a triangle to the lower portion of the oval.



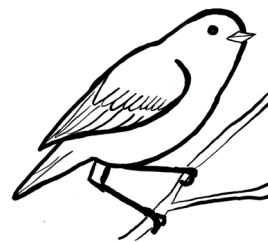
3. Time to add a wing! Draw a curve starting near the head and bring it down towards the tail. Then draw a line back up towards the back of the body.



4. Erase all the areas in red.



5. Draw a small diamond with a line down the center to create a beak and a small dot for an eye. The beak of the yellow warbler is perfect for catching insects!



6. Add two sections of feathers to the wing using curved lines. The lower feathers should be longer and thinner than the upper feathers. Add a couple lines to the tail. Color!
